My Priorities - Kim Richter

1. Lower and more reasonable taxes

If it's working, keep it. If it's broken, fix it. If it's not useful, get rid of it. Adopt extensive program review together with zero-based budgeting.

2. Job Creation

More and better paying jobs closer to home particularly for our youth.

3. Safer streets and neighbourhoods for all

Especially for our children and seniors; Enhanced public safety.

4. More accessible and frequent public transit to all areas of Langley Township

Especially Aldergrove, Gloucester and other areas of the Township; Add night buses from Vancouver to Langley, not just to Surrey.

5. Healthy communities with accessible and affordable recreational programs and facilities

Including additional recreational facilities and services in Aldergrove especially for children and youth; More pedestrian, horse, and bike paths.

6. Protection of the Township's water resources, aquifers, farm land and wildlife corridors

Our rural lands and resources make us unique in the Lower Mainland and must be preserved for future generations.

7. More comprehensive long term planning for sustainable, healthy and safe neighbourhoods
